



STUDENT EXCHANGE AGREEMENT

Between

EPITECH, France

And

CHITKARA UNIVERSITY, India

EPITECH and Chitkara University desire to provide their students with overseas curricula and to share a common mission to provide the highest-quality education.

The purpose of this Agreement is to enhance the educational experiences and the cultural exchange of students and faculty from both institutions.

1. Definition

Within the framework of this Agreement, “home university/institution” refers to the institution in which a student is formally enrolled as a degree candidate. “Host university/institution” refers to the institution that has agreed to receive students from the home institution for a period of study on a non-degree basis. Students applying for this exchange program should be full-time registered students from both institutions.

2. Exchange of Students

- a. Each semester within the duration of this Agreement, each institution may send up to four (4) undergraduate students and / or master students to be enrolled at the host institution. The exchange period may be a semester or an academic year.
- b. Chitkara University will be responsible for screening and selecting applicants from its university for the exchange.
- c. EPITECH will select students having completed 3 years’ studies in Software and IT.
- d. EPITECH students will have access to the courses in English in the Computer Science & Engineering Program at Chitkara University.
- e. Students from both institutions will register in their university of origin, but will enjoy all the privileges in accordance with students at the host institution.

- h. Courses selected and credits obtained by students at host institutions should be reviewed and recognized by relevant departments of home university according to its regulations.

3. Tuition and Fees

- a. Students will pay tuition fees to the home university and will be responsible for their own travel, subsistence expenses and other personal expenses.
- b. Students will not be charged tuition fees by the host institution but may be required to (or may select to) pay certain ancillary fees (for example, for on-campus health services, library fee, computer fee and book cost) as listed by host institution/university.

4. Academic calendar

Epitech

Fall semester: September to January

Spring semester: February to June

Only the program of Fall Semester will be offered to exchange students willing study for one Semester at Epitech

Chitkara

Fall Semester: August to December

Spring Semester: January to May

Courses offered in the both the semesters are open for Exchange students from partner institutions.

5. Visa

- a. Each participating student will be responsible for obtaining his/her own visa and completing the required immigration procedures needed to pursue studies at the host institution.
- b. The host institution agrees to provide an acceptance letter and other necessary documentation to be used by the student in obtaining visa.

6. Housing

Each institution will provide assistance to arriving students to secure suitable on /off campus housing for their study period. The cost of said housing shall be paid by the student.

7. Health/Medical Insurance Coverage

Students from both institutions shall be required to have appropriate health and medical insurance within the duration of their stay at the host institution.

8. General Provisions

- a. The departments involved in the exchange at the home university will provide academic counseling to ensure that the academic courses taken at the host institution are acceptable to the home institution. The host institution will provide course descriptions and syllabuses to aid course equivalency evaluation.
- b. Participants in the exchange will be governed by the same regulations and performance standards that pertain to other students at the host institution.

9. Rights and Responsibilities

- a. Academic achievement transcripts will be sent to the student's home institution at the conclusion of each semester.
- b. No monetary consideration will be involved between the two institutions, nor will there be any indemnities, reimbursements, or sharing of fees or profits arising from the exchange program.

10. Program Liaison

Each institution will appoint a program coordinator to ensure that the study proceeds according to a reasonable schematic plan and to ensure the terms of this Agreement are carried out. Each institution may name a successor to, or replacement of, its coordinator. Each program coordinator will ensure that the partner institution is available to all information appropriate to the promotion of the program.

11. Duration, Amendment, Approval and Termination of Agreement

- a. This Agreement shall be valid upon the signature of both parties for three (3) years. It shall be subject to revision, modification or renewal by mutual written agreement.
- b. The Agreement may be terminated at the request of either institution, provided that either party gives the other party written notice at least twelve (12) months before the termination date. Any termination of the Agreement must take into account the rights of students already participating in or accepted for the exchange to complete their study.

12. Indemnification

Either party shall guarantee the other party against indemnifying the cost arising from claims, lawsuits, loss or damage for the act or omission in enforcing the Agreement, or for the act of commission or oversight by its employees, agents or students in carrying out the Agreement.

Article 3: Other expenses

The “Exchange” students will be responsible for the following costs and expenses:

All participating exchange students are required to carry adequate health insurance and to provide proof to the host institution upon arrival.
