



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

University College Birmingham (UCB) Summer Row Birmingham, B3 1JB United Kingdom Chitkara University Chandigarh-Patiala National Highway (NH-64), Punjab 140401, India

Date Memorandum is to take effect: 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022

- This Memorandum of Understanding recognises the intention of Chitkara University and University College Birmingham (UCB), to establish a relationship to co-operate on a broad range of areas including:
  - Explore potential progression opportunities for courses delivered at both Universities subject to mapping modules, learning agreements and contracted teaching hours.
  - Skill development or upskilling of students in a variety of different subject areas and levels.
  - Explore opportunities for short courses and mobility of academic staff.
  - To explore opportunities for collaboration and to promote co-operation in teaching and research.

The aim of this Memorandum is to provide a framework within which the parties will seek to develop a formal collaborative relationship.

- Both parties recognise the value of this Memorandum of Understanding in promoting its own programmes and activities. However, any marketing material/activity which includes reference to the other Party must be sent to that Party and be approved before use.
- 3. The development of a collaborative relationship between the parties is subject to (a) the approval of the relevant authorities of each party in accordance with its internal academic procedures; and (b) obtaining all necessary or advisable governmental, regulatory or other relevant approvals, consents or licences.
- 4. This MOU is effective from the day the representative of both institutions sign below and will continue for 3 year in the first instance, and will be reviewed thereafter. Each party has the right to discontinue the arrangements subject to a period of 6 months' notice being given. This Understanding may also be terminated at any time by mutual consent of all the parties.
- In any cases of discontinuance, the parties will honour agreed commitments either via the accepted arrangements or by suitable negotiated alternatives.





6. This Memorandum of Understanding signifies a statement of intention to collaborate, but is not a legally binding document and has no force of law.
