

10th International Advanced Diagnostic Techniques Symposium
“Recent Trends in Diagnosis and Therapy in Present Day Healthcare”

The inauguration of 10th international ADT - Advanced Diagnostic Techniques Symposium, Theme - Recent Trends in Diagnosis and therapy in present day healthcare, was held in Exploratorium, Chitkara University, Punjab campus on 29th March 2022. The symposium was held in blended mode from 29th March to 31st March 2022. Almost 400 Delegates have registered for the symposium and more than 50 abstracts have been selected for Oral and Poster sessions.
