


A chronicle of RISE





It is undoubtedly one of the riskiest businesses in which to invest money, yet it is perceived by the general public to be excessively profitable. The major pharma companies rightly promote themselves as being research-based organizations, yet most people believe that they spend more on marketing than on research. Despite the acknowledged risks and costs associated with pharmaceutical development, many citizens still believe that pharmaceuticals should be being developed to meet all human needs and that when developed they should be given away to everyone on the basis of need. This FDP aimed to provide a basic understanding of how the industry works and attempts to provide an explanation for some of its contradictions. Workshop on Writing Proposals for Publishing Textbooks

Date: 29th June, 2017

In this competitive academic arena, every faculty is required to enhance publishing skills along with teaching-learning process. In addition to writing and publishing technical papers in the proceeding of conferences and journals, an idea of authoring a textbook in one's domain, and that too with a renowned international publisher, is an exciting one. It looks like a dream come true to be recognized as experienced academician at global level. A faculty development workshop on 'Writing Proposals for Publishing Textbooks' was organized on June 29, 2017 at Chitkara University Punjab.

T. L. Singal, Professor, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, Chitkara University, Punjab conducted this workshop as the resource person. He is author of four technical textbooks: Wireless Communications (2010), Analog & Digital Communications (2012), and Digital Communication (2015) – published by McGraw Hill Education, and Optical Fiber Communications (2016-17) – published by Cambridge University Press at International level.

Total 37 faculty members of different departments participated actively in this interactive workshop and deliberated the essential components of a Book Proposal Form (BPF). To begin with, the benefits of publishing a textbook in one's domain with international publisher were highlighted. It followed with 3-steps writing process — choosing the right topic, developing contents including unique pedagogical features, and submitting the detailed book proposal form as per the publisher's requirements. It was emphasized that writing style and structure of the text script should be modular, well supported with examples and applications.

The outlines of BPF include the information about the basic concept, the contents, outstanding features, planned pedagogy, type of artworks (figures, tables, charts, graphs, images), format (projected number of printed pages), sample chapters, supplementary materials (instructor's manual, solutions manual, presentation slides, test bank, online quiz, comparative study with competitive books, tentative schedule, list of reviewers and author's CV. Each aspect was discussed in details with the example of a published book by the resource person.

The experience of entire process of publishing a text book - from proposal to multiple reviews/revisions of complete manuscript, developing appendices and preface, was shared. A lot of queries were satisfactorily answered on the spot. The workshop concluded with vote of thanks and promise to continue the process from concept to publish with interested authors.

Just as light waves have a "signature" of color, sound waves that resonate in a microphone from a vocal tract have a signature known as "formants." Participants Formants are how NLP enables conversational interfaces to recognize each sound and compose individual words and sentences. Mr Shashidhar, was has been an active media personnel, was also the Director, Indira School of Communication, Pune, talked at length on the do's and dont's for media professionals and the media's right to inform people. 
