(57) Abstract:

The present disclosure relates to a system and method for importing metadata identifier. The method includes receiving a metadata identifier in a pre-defined format. The method also includes authenticating a user for logging into an information server upon fulfilling one or more pre-defined criteria. The method further includes selecting a new host computer to add a machine which runs a pre-defined database, upon selecting a source option. The method also includes generating a unique identifier for each metadata record and assigning the unique identifier for ensuring an authenticity and providing a primary key for links.
