(57) Abstract:

Embodiments of the present disclosure relates to a system (100) and method (300) for custodian-based routing of content in a content-centric network. In an aspect, the system comprises a processor (202) coupled to a memory (204). The memory (204) stores processor-executable instructions. The processor (202) is configured to receive a request for the content from a content requestor. Further, the processor (202) is configured to select a custodian to provide the requested content. Next, the processor (202) is configured to search for the requested content in a repository. In the end, the processor (202) is configured to deliver the content to the content requestor.
