## (57) Abstract:

A system 100 having decentralized platform for freelancers is introduced. The system 100 enables first entities i.e. freelancer 108 and second entities i.e. company 106 to readily view, and securely connect with each other. The second entities 106 initially post a project specification through a freelancing platform 110. Second entities 106 compete with one another by submitting proposals for the project through a freelancing platform 110. When a proposal is selected by the first entities 108, can correspondingly construct a team that includes one or more first entities 108 who complete the project under the supervision. As milestones are completed, the first entities 108 can be paid from an account maintained by the second entities 106. Additionally, or alternatively, invoices for work completed by first entities' team could be generated and delivered to the second entities.
